7. Include recipe which is protected with a clear covering. Recipes should be printed or typed on 3x5 cards if necessary. Use the front of the recipe cards only. One or two cards may be used.
8. All foods will be considered unsafe for consumption at the end of the Fair, and will be disposed of. Food and recipes **will not be** returned to the exhibitor.
9. One "Best of Show" ribbon will be awarded per class as judge sees fit.
